Lt. Governor Patrick Assigns Senator Hall to Influential Committees

(Austin, TX) - On Friday, Lieutenant Governor Dan Patrick assigned Senate members to the now fourteen standing committees. Senator Bob Hall gained influential positions for a first-time senator, receiving seats on four powerful committees that will control key issues of the senator's campaign platform.

He gained the enviable position of Vice Chair on Border Security, a subcommittee of Veteran's Affairs and Military Installations, where he plans to actively support legislation that protects Texas by addressing the issue of illegal aliens and securing the Texas border. He also gained a seat on the highly sought after Transportation Committee where he will champion free roads though discipline spending and expanding free-market principles by protecting property rights.

"I am humbled by these appointments," said Senator Hall. "In addition to working on the issues I campaigned on, these appointments allow me to represent the values and concerns of my constituents. I look forward to a productive session."

Other influential appointments include a seat on the Natural Resources and Economic Development Committee and the Agriculture, Water, and Rural Affairs Committee. Senator Hall plans to use his positions to advance commonsense conservative legislation and halt legislation that would have a negative impact on the principles of liberty and Texas' economic stability.
