

- Greater focus on proactive versus reactive approach.
- Additional coordination of statewide and metropolitan planning activities, technical data collection, and information sharing.
- Integration of Statewide and Metropolitan Transportation Plans.
- Expanded emphasis on multi-region planning and coordination.
- Continued commitment to partnership communication.



MPO/TxDOT Areas for Improvement

- Centralized decision-making when regional is appropriate
 - Intelligent Transportation Systems management
 - Bypassing MTP and conformity staging when advancing projects
 - Financial commitments eroding
 - Proposition 12 process and outcome
 - Focus on individual projects, rather than a system



MPO/TxDOT Areas of Improvement

(cont.)

- 2. Greater focus needed on streamlining processes (TxDOT can build a project in a shorter amount of time than it takes to get environmental clearance)
 - RTC revenues for more staff not supported
 - Sense of rivalry with other agencies can slow process
 - Long timeline to complete agreements now improving
 - Role of public involvement
- 3. Lack of horizontal financial information system
 - Texas Mobility funds
 - Category 2 funds
 - CMAQ and STP(MM) funds
