SEN. NATHAN JOHNSON ANNOUNCES COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS

AUSTIN - Texas State Senator Nathan Johnson (D-Dallas) today announced his committee assignments for the 86th Texas Legislature. Lieutenant Governor Dan Patrick appointed Johnson to serve on the Health and Human Services, Veteran Affairs and Border Security, Water and Rural Affairs, and Administration Committees.

"I am honored to serve the citizens of the State of Texas and Senate District 16 on these committees and grateful to the Lieutenant Governor for this opportunity," said Johnson. "We have the knowledge and the means to improve the health and quality of life for all Texans, to develop more effective and efficient systems of delivering care, and in the process to strengthen and grow our economy."

Johnson continued, "Sound management of the state's water resources is of critical importance in the face of increasing demand, climate instability, and the necessity to preserve the integrity of our environment."

"Importantly, as a State Senator my obligations and my opportunities to influence policy extend well beyond my committee assignments. I intend to participate in all matters affecting my constituents and the people of this state," Johnson concluded.

Senator Nathan Johnson was elected in 2018 to represent the economically and demographically diverse Texas Senate District 16. Johnson practices commercial litigation at the law firm he co-founded, and he lives in Dallas with his wife, Anne, and three children.
