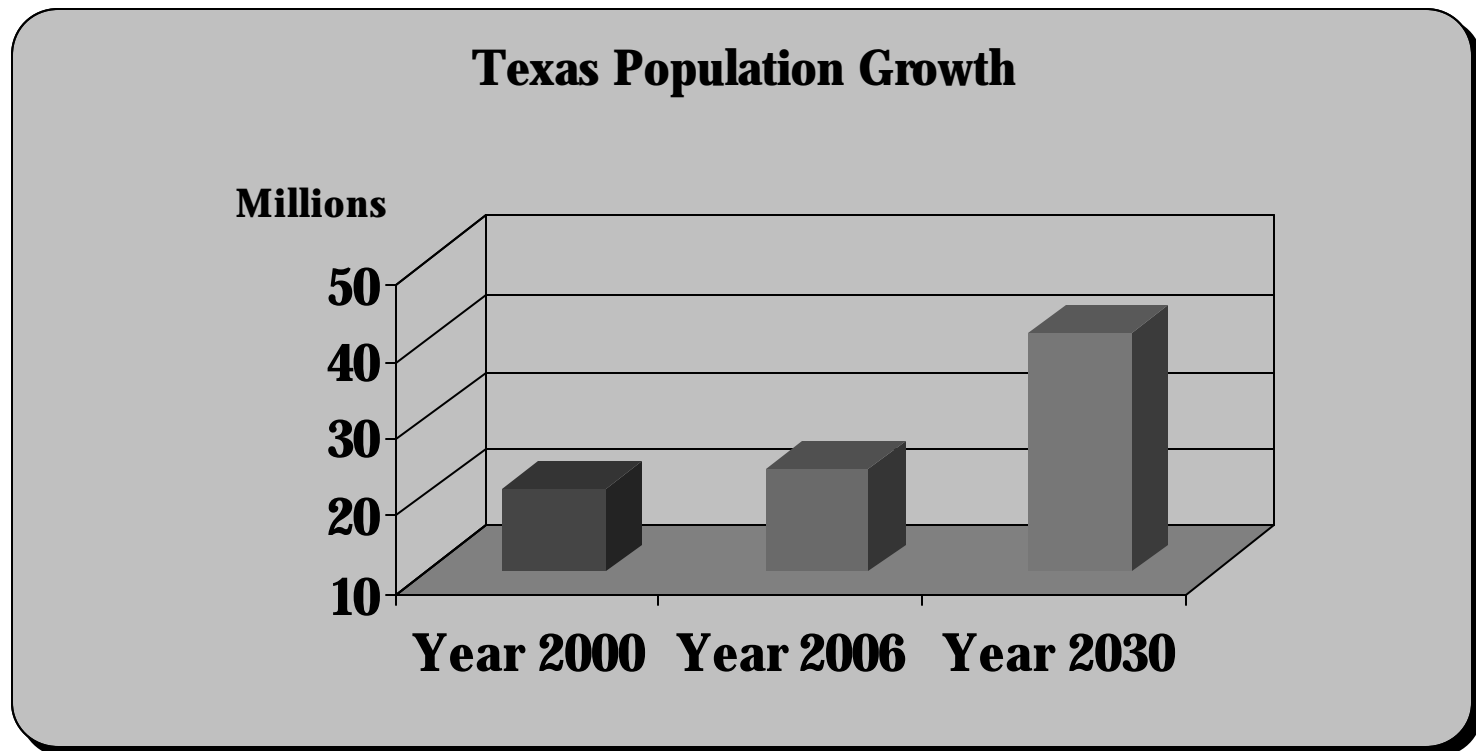

Dallas County Growth

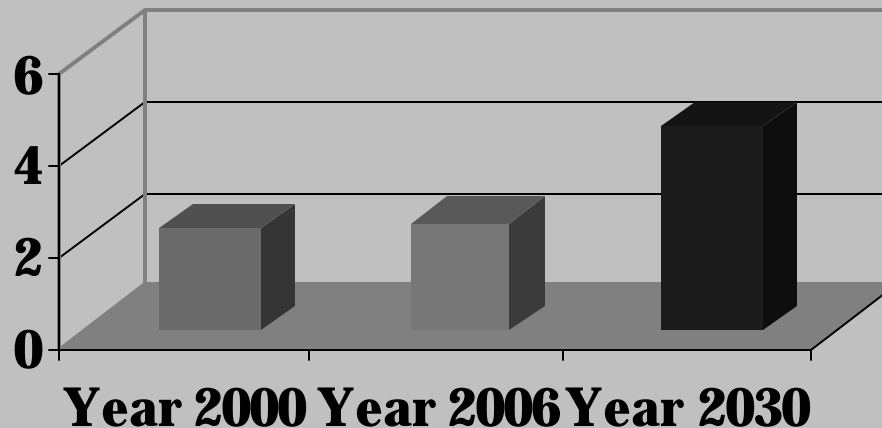

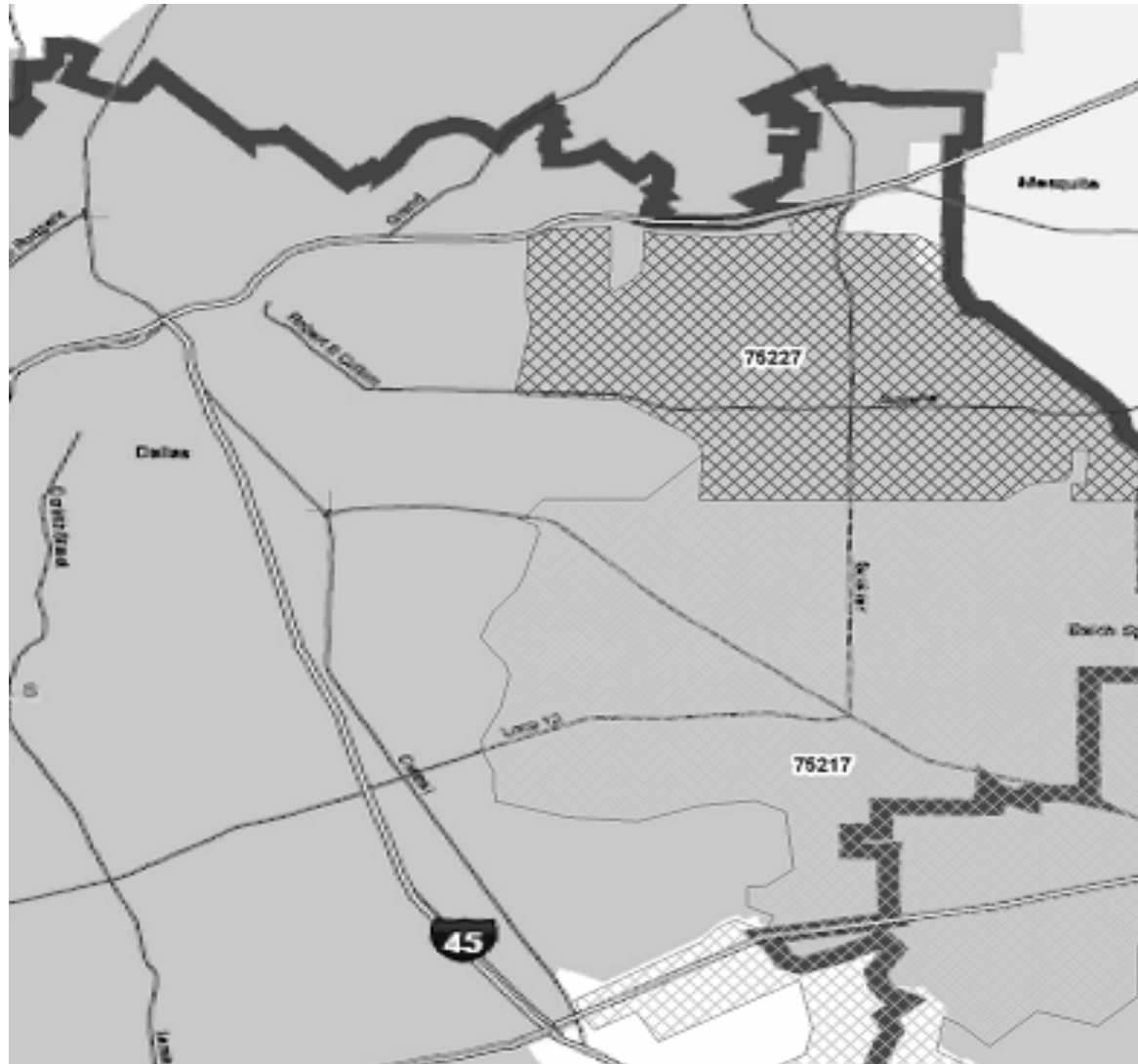

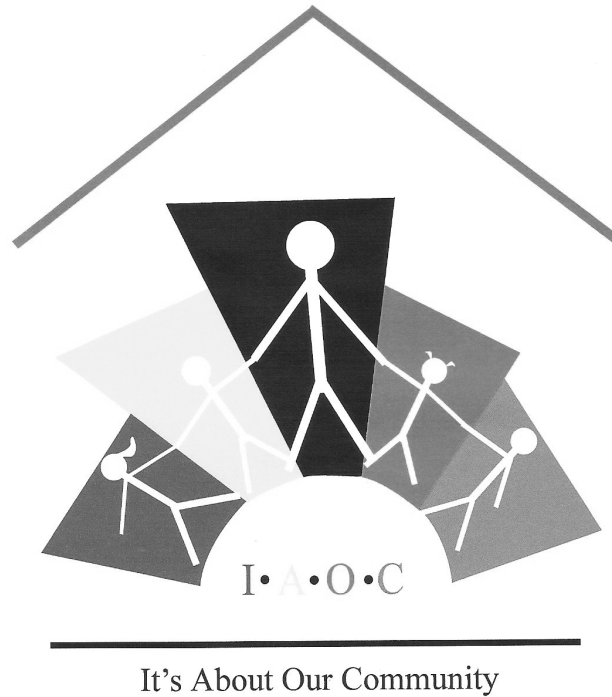
