- Most of our member districts already have a transfer policy in place. A majority of those policies give employees desiring a transfer priority during the interview process for the next school year. To allow a current teacher to transfer immediately is not in the best interest of their current students. As written, the bill could create a domino effect that would never cease.
- The posting requirements in most of our member district would require a full time staff member. Districts don't want to wait before filling vacancies and many have employees under contract that are being used as full time substitutes that they move into newly created openings.
- All posting requirements usually slow down the hiring process and parents want qualified, certified teachers with their students immediately when a teaching position becomes available.
