Contestant Categories

- ☆ One winner will be selected from each of the following two art categories: grades K-5 and grades 6-8.
- ↑ Three winners will be selected from the poetry category of grades 9-12.
- The winners' artwork or poetry will be displayed at the Texas State Capitol from Monday, March 30-Wednesday, April 1. Contestants will be notified via phone on Thursday, April 2 if they are selected as a winner.

Recognition of the Five Winners on Tuesday, April 7, 2009 at the Texas State Capitol

- Winners will be invited to breakfast with Texas State Legislators in the Lt. Governor's Reception room were there the entries will be displayed.
- Winners will be recognized by the Texas Senate and will receive a framed resolution adopted by the Texas Senate in honor of Military Child Day at the Texas State Capitol.
- ☆ Winners will also receive a commemorative medal.

Winners will have their art/poetry displayed in the Texas Senate Committee on Veteran Affairs & Military Installations office at the Texas State Capitol for the remainder of the 81st Regular Legislative Session.
