



To the Members of the Texas Legislature,

I'm writing as a deeply concerned constituent who is frustrated and disheartened by the direction of your current focus. At a time when Texas should be prioritizing safety, infrastructure, and emergency preparedness, you are instead spending time and resources on redrawing political districts—a move that feels less like governance and more like political gamesmanship.

Your job is to lead—and we are watching how you spend our time and money. Please stop wasting it on political

maneuvering and start addressing the real issues facing Texans. Lives, livelihoods, and the future of our state depend on it.
