Message:

Texas is already subject to great amounts of gerrymandering from Republicans. I reside in Irving and I'm in the same congressional district as someone in Cherokee County (over 100 miles away). My district (TX-6th) was drawn in a way that undermines Democratic votes in Dallas County. In the most recent election, the Republican candidate Jake Ellzey won by over 30 percent, primarily because of the way my district was drawn. Republicans have control over a higher percentage of seats in the state compared to their vote share (for instance, 66% of TX house seats when winning 58% of the popular vote in 2024). Further continuation of gerrymandering the state is unfair to Democratic voters in the state. Our voices are being silenced and this should be considered a blatant attack on democracy. I ask for the state of Texas to not move forward with redistricting to benefit Republicans even more.
