My name is Charlene Shafer. I live in Cypress, Congressional District 38. One of the two new majority white districts created during the 2021 redistricting despite the census data showing the population growth was primarily people of color. The census reports whites are 45% of the population but control 60% of the congressional districts. It should be no surprise that the current maps are still being reviewed by a federal court.
