



Dear Members of the Texas Senate,

I write to urge you to oppose the current redistricting maps under consideration. These maps are not only deeply flawed—they undermine the principles of representative democracy and erode public trust in our institutions.

The proposed maps dilute the voting power of communities of color, despite the fact that nearly all of Texas’s recent population growth has come from Latino, Black, and Asian communities. Moreover, the maps are engineered to entrench partisan power rather than ensure fair representation. Drawing districts that predetermine outcomes serves political interests—not the people of Texas. This practice breeds cynicism, lowers voter turnout, and weakens our democracy.

I ask you to consider the long-term damage of prioritizing short-term political gains over the integrity of our electoral system. Texas deserves maps that reflect its diversity and honor every citizen’s right to fair representation.

Reject these gerrymandered maps. Support transparent, nonpartisan redistricting. Uphold democracy.
