I am writing to express my strong disapproval and concern regarding the proposed redistricting maps currently under consideration.

This redistricting effort appears to be a blatant attempt at partisan gerrymandering, one that threatens the principles of fair representation and undermines the democratic process. Instead of reflecting the true diversity and demographic growth of Texas (particularly among communities of color) the maps dilute the voting power of these groups and skew districts in ways that do not reflect actual population shifts or community interests.

My primary concerns include:

- 1. Racial and Ethnic Disenfranchisement: The new maps appear to reduce the electoral influence of Black, Latino, and Asian communities, despite these groups accounting for the vast majority of population growth in the state. This raises serious concerns under the Voting Rights Act.
- 2. Lack of Transparency and Public Input: The redistricting process has been rushed, with minimal public engagement and limited time for constituents to review and comment on the proposals. This undermines public trust and accountability.
- 3. Partisan Gerrymandering: The maps prioritize political advantage over fair representation. Gerrymandered districts entrench political power and reduce electoral competition, ultimately weakening our democracy.
- 4. Community Fragmentation: Many proposed districts divide cohesive communities, particularly in urban and suburban areas, making it more difficult for residents to advocate for shared local needs and priorities.

I urge the Texas Senate to reject any redistricting plan that undermines fair representation. Texans deserve electoral maps that are transparent, equitable, and reflective of the true makeup of our state—not drawn to favor any political party or suppress the voices of its residents.
