Honorable Members of the Texas Legislature,

I am writing to submit this testimony in strong opposition to the proposed congressional redistricting plan (PlanC2308/SB 4) currently under consideration by the Texas Legislature. As a concerned Texas citizen, I urge you to reject this redistricting proposal for the following critical reasons:

Violation of Voting Rights and Equal Representation

This redistricting plan fundamentally undermines the voting rights of communities of color across Texas. The proposal deliberately dismantles four congressional districts that the U.S. Department of Justice has identified as protecting the voting rights of Black and Hispanic voters. Specifically, the plan:

- Splits voters of color in Tarrant County among multiple neighboring Republican districts, diluting their voting power
- Alters the shape of the 35th Congressional District in Central Texas, which was originally created by court order to protect the voting rights of people of color
- Targets Democratic-held districts in the Austin, Dallas, and Houston metro areas, as well as South Texas, where communities of color have significant representation
- **Partisan Gerrymandering at Its Worst**

This redistricting effort represents blatant partisan gerrymandering designed to guarantee Republican electoral victories rather than ensure fair representation. The plan is explicitly designed to:

- Create five additional districts that would have voted for Trump by at least 10 percentage points in 2024
- Increase Republican control from the current 66% to an even more disproportionate level
- Follow presidential directives rather than serve the interests of all Texans
- **Lack of Public Input and Transparency**

The rushed timeline and secretive process surrounding this redistricting effort deny Texas citizens meaningful participation in decisions affecting their representation for the next decade. The Legislature is attempting to fast-track this proposal without adequate time for public review, comment, and deliberation.

Constitutional and Legal Concerns

This redistricting plan violates state and federal constitutional requirements for fair representation. The deliberate targeting of minority communities and the explicit partisan motivation behind the map changes raise serious legal questions that will likely result in costly litigation for Texas taxpayers.

Recommendation

I respectfully urge you to:

1. Reject the current redistricting proposal (PlanC2308/SB 4) 2. Implement a transparent, inclusive redistricting process that prioritizes fair representation over partisan advantage 3. Ensure that any new congressional maps protect the voting rights of all Texans, including communities of color 4. Allow adequate time for meaningful public input and review

The integrity of our democracy depends on fair electoral maps that represent the true will of the people, not the partisan interests of politicians. Texas deserves better than a redistricting process designed to predetermine electoral outcomes and silence the voices of minority communities.

I ask that you vote against this redistricting proposal and work toward a fair, transparent process that serves all Texans equally.
