I'm here today to represent myself and opposition to the thought of redistricting in my state.

This decision — whether it involves changing lives — we are already facing so much it is so deeply concerning the direction that we are taking.

Without sufficient notice or clear justification, it sends the message that public input is an afterthought. Community members are re-arranging their Saturdays to make it known — and a sudden redirection undermines their ability to participate. You're including us today, but excluding us in many ways. We are not fairly represented. Look at the Census. This is 2025 minorities make up the majority of Tejas.

Transparency in government depends on consistency and accessibility. if it involves decisions that impact our schools, infrastructure, environment, or healthcare — limits community oversight and their right to choose effective leaders and erodes public trust.

We expect — and deserve — a Senate that values input from all constituents, not just those who happen to benefit from changes in administration. If the goal is to serve the people of North Texas, then any changes to public meetings should enhance access, not reduce it.

I respectfully urge the Senate to reconsider this redirection, provide a clear and public explanation for the change, and ensure that future meetings are planned with the full participation of the community in mind.
