



To the Members of the Texas Legislature,

I write today as a concerned Texan to strongly oppose House Bill 4.

Regardless of political affiliation, all Texans should agree on one thing: voters should choose their representatives, not the other way around. HB 4 undermines this principle by manipulating district lines to give one party a disproportionate advantage — not through competition or ideas, but through the drawing of maps behind closed doors.
