I am writing to express my strong dissatisfaction with the recent congressional redistricting decisions made in the state of Texas.

The new maps do not reflect the population growth and demographic changes of our state. Instead of promoting fair representation, these maps dilute the voting power of communities like mine and appear to be drawn to favor political outcomes, not the interests of the people. This is unacceptable in a representative democracy.

Redistricting should be about fair, transparent, and data-driven decision-making not about preserving political power. I am especially concerned that:

- Communities of color have been divided or packed in ways that weaken their influence.
- Competitive districts have been redrawn into safe seats, reducing voter choice and accountability.
