I am a resident of Kemah, in Galveston County, and I am outraged by the proposed redistricting maps. This plan is a shameless act of political manipulation designed to protect power, not people. It slices up our communities, drowns out our voices, and hands our representation to those who didn't earn it and don't deserve it.

Galveston County has already been at the center of voter suppression tactics, and now you are doubling down with maps that further dilute the political power of Black, Latino, and working-class Texans. Over 95 percent of Texas's population growth in the last decade came from people of color, yet these maps do everything possible to minimize their influence. That is not a coincidence. It is a calculated move to sideline the majority for the benefit of a shrinking political minority.
