To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing as a concerned Texas resident to strongly oppose the current effort to redraw congressional maps during this unscheduled, mid-decade redistricting process.

Redistricting is meant to reflect population changes based on the decennial census—not to serve partisan interests between cycles. Attempting to redraw districts now, without clear court mandates or sufficient public input, undermines public trust in the democratic process and signals an abuse of legislative power.

Moreover, the move appears aimed at manipulating district lines to entrench partisan advantage at the expense of fair representation—especially for minority communities whose voices have historically been marginalized. Texas should not be using recent legal developments as an excuse to reduce representation for diverse and growing populations.

I urge the Legislature to halt this process immediately and instead commit to transparent, inclusive, and constitutionally sound redistricting—ideally through an independent or bipartisan commission in future cycles. Our democracy deserves better than rushed, politically motivated redistricting in the shadows of a special session.
