This letter expresses concerns about proposals to redraw Texas' congressional district maps during the ongoing special legislative session.

It's important to ensure that any adjustments uphold fair representation and avoid diluting minority voting strength, as prohibited by the 14th Amendment and the Voting Rights Act.

Reports suggest these redistricting efforts are driven by partisan motives. Some analyses, like the one presented by the League of United Latin American Citizens, suggest these changes could disenfranchise minority voters and target existing Democratic districts.

A mid-decade redistricting is unnecessary and disruptive. The current maps have been in effect since the 2021 redistricting process. The redistricting process should prioritize fair and equitable representation for all Texans. Texas' diverse population requires districts that reflect the state's demographics and allow voters to elect candidates of their choice, not districts designed to favor one political party over another.
