Thank you for this opportunity to express my concerns regarding the Texas mid-decade Redistricting. There has been far too little time and information provided for informed public awareness and comments. The redistricting effort in my opinion is not in the interest of free and fair elections. Taken in combination with the political winds so evident now, this represents not only improper gerrymandering but also voter suppression and dark money in our political system. I have seen the example in my own city of San Antonio with the intimidation of Hispanic community organizations who dare to legally register eligible voters. I am very familiar with the voter registration process in Texas and all of the regulations already in place. Voter suppression through a so-called redistricting process like this is the issue and not voter fraud. The fact that Texas has a documented history of racial discrimination and voter suppression should give us pause. We can note the 2021 litigation involving Texas that is still making its way through the courts. The redistricting is neither fair or just or in the interests of the people of Texas or the kind of example to set for our country. This is on the wrong side of history for such a great state. It seems to me to be a cowardly and cynical response to the forces of tyranny to which too many of our political, institutional, and business leaders have capitulated.
