Message:

I am writing to express my strong opposition to the recently proposed redistricting maps in Texas. The current proposals appear to prioritize partisan interests over fair representation, diluting the voices of communities—particularly communities of color—that have contributed significantly to Texas’ population growth.

Redistricting should reflect the principles of representative democracy: equity, transparency, and accountability. Instead, these maps reinforce gerrymandering tactics that fragment communities, diminish electoral competitiveness, and undermine public trust in the democratic process.

Texas is one of the most diverse states in the country. Any redistricting plan must ensure that historically marginalized communities have a fair opportunity to elect candidates of their choice, as required under the Voting Rights Act. Unfortunately, the proposed maps fall short of this obligation and appear designed to entrench power rather than represent the people.

I urge you to reject any redistricting plan that weakens voter influence through manipulation of district lines. Texans deserve maps that are drawn transparently, guided by data, and free from partisan bias.
