I am a Texas resident and voter deeply concerned about the process and content of the proposed congressional redistricting map.

First and foremost, I am extremely alarmed that the Senate is moving forward with a hearing despite the House lacking quorum. This undermines the democratic principle of full legislative representation and diminishes public trust in this process. The public deserves a transparent, inclusive redistricting process that reflects the diversity and needs of our communities, not one rushed through under incredibly questionable circumstances.

The proposed map prioritizes political power over fair representation. It dilutes the voting strength of communities of color, particularly in rapidly growing areas where Latino, Black, and Asian populations have driven population increases. This is not only morally unacceptable, it may also violate federal protections under the Voting Rights Act.

I urge this committee to:

Pause the process until the House quorum is restored and all voices in the legislature are present.

Ensure transparency by allowing sufficient time for the public to review, understand, and comment on the maps.

Draw fair maps that accurately reflect the growth and diversity of our state, and that ensure communities of interest are kept whole rather than split for political gain.

We know what this is. We see what you're doing. Texans deserve a process that puts voters first, not politicians. I respectfully ask that you reconsider this course of action and recommit to a redistricting process that is fair, lawful, and worthy of the people you serve.
