You'd invest in candidates with compelling ideas—not in manipulating district lines to guarantee outcomes. The fact that this is your focus, in the middle of a legislative term, speaks volumes.

This mid-cycle redistricting scheme is cowardice masquerading as strategy. It is antidemocratic. It is indefensible. And the people of Texas are watching.
