Message:

I strongly oppose the current redistricting maps in Texas, which continue to undermine fair representation and weaken the voices of millions of Texans—especially communities of color and urban voters. These maps do not reflect the population growth and diversity that Texas has experienced in the last decade. Instead, they preserve partisan power at the expense of democratic principles. Rather than drawing maps that give every voter an equal say, the current plans entrench incumbents and suppress competition. Districts have been manipulated to dilute the influence of Black, Latino, and Asian communities, despite these groups accounting for nearly all of the state’s population growth.

The most egregiously gerrymandered district that you should be looking at instead is Congressional District 35: A bizarre strip running from Austin to San Antonio, clearly designed to pack Democratic voters into one district while splitting surrounding communities.

Texans deserve competitive districts that respect geographic and community boundaries—not maps that serve the interests of a few politicians. The redistricting process should be transparent, equitable, and reflective of the Texas of today—not the political status quo of the past.
