I'm writing as a concerned Texas resident to express my strong opposition to any proposed redistricting efforts in our state at this time. 4. It Prioritizes Politicians Over People  
Too often, redistricting is used as a tool for incumbents to protect their seats instead of ensuring fair and competitive elections. Voters

should choose their representatives, not the other way around.

#### 5. It Wastes Public Resources

The legal battles, public hearings, and administrative changes that come with redistricting cost time and taxpayer money—resources that could be better spent on education, healthcare, infrastructure, or disaster preparedness.

Texas deserves fair, stable, and representative governance. I urge you to oppose any unnecessary or politically driven attempts to redistrict our state. Our democracy depends on transparency, fairness, and respect for the voices of all Texans.
