Message:

I am writing in opposition of the proposed redistricting map and in opposition to redistricting in general this year. There is no valid legal basis to do so now as there is no court order. The timing of the proposed redistricting is highly unusual and stems solely from political pressure. What happened to Texas being independent and to the argument for state's rights? Why is the Texas State Legislature taking up redistricting just because the President wants 5 more seats in the House of Representatives? As a native Texan and Houstonian, I am disappointed in Texas' elected officials who support this redistricting effort. This is an attempt to disenfranchise the good, hard working people of Texas. Texas is a majority-minority state and this proposed action seeks to dilute my voice, along with millions of others, through racist gerrymandering. It is clearly a power grab and the naked ambition of those who know their policies are unpopular and therefore are unlikely to win on the merits. In a state where one party has received 51-53% of the votes in state wide elections, this redistricting map seeks to have that same party control 79% of the congressional districts.
