My name is Josalyn Cano, and I am a Texas resident and active participant in our democratic process. I am here today to voice my deep concern about ongoing redistricting practices in Texas that have resulted in the dilution of minority voting power and the erosion of fair representation.

Despite communities of color accounting for over 95% of Texas's population growth in the last decade, recent redistricting maps fail to reflect this demographic reality. Instead, we have seen districts redrawn in ways that fracture Latino, Black, and Asian communities—minimizing their ability to elect representatives of their choice. This is not just unjust—it is

unconstitutional.
