To the Senate Special Committee on Congressional redistricting:

This redistricting process is becoming MADDENING: I just got used to my current Congressional person and now the district will change again! My district is "moving" around my house for the last 25 years. With each election cycle it becomes more and more difficult for me to figure how, where to vote and who to vote for.

I urge the Committee to

- 1) Prevent communities of color from being deliberately divided, thereby weakening their political voice. (Texas has a long history of racial gerrymandering and discriminatory voting practices.)
- 2) Oppose any mid-decade redistricting—especially while the current maps are still being challenged in court.
