I am a resident and registered voter in your district, writing to express my deep concern regarding the proposed mid-decade congressional redistricting currently under consideration by the Texas Legislature. As you know, this redistricting follows a recent federal court ruling and a directive from the U.S. Department of Justice to address so-called “coalition” districts. However, what is being presented to voters is far more than a judicial compliance measure—it is a political maneuver that risks undermining the democratic principle of fair and effective representation.

Redrawing districts mid-stream to benefit one party, often referred to as “gerrymandering,” threatens to erode public confidence in our democratic institutions. The proposed maps would likely dilute the voting strength of minority and urban communities by fracturing them or merging them into larger districts dominated by partisan interests
