Dear Members of the Senate Special Committee on Congressional Redistricting,

I am writing today as a concerned Texas resident to strongly oppose the proposed congressional redistricting maps under consideration. The redistricting process must be rooted in fairness, transparency, and a commitment to equal representation — not partisan advantage.
