### **Robert "Bob" Hall is Sworn In As State Senator for District 2**

(*Austin, TX*) - Senator Bob Hall was sworn into office yesterday, *Tuesday, January 13* after defeating the 12-year incumbent of Senate District 2. Senator Hall has begun his term by introducing several bills that increase liberty, protect private property, and enhance transparency. As an example, one piece of legislation will protect property owners by denying privately owned corporations the authority to condemn land. Senator Hall believes that property owners should be protected from private companies that would exploit the right of eminent domain, effectively banning "public private partnerships" that hand public roads to private corporations. Additionally, the Senator is pursuing an upgraded security policy for Texas' electrical grid in order to protect citizens and businesses from the harm that an electromagnetic pulse (EMP) would do to the state's infrastructure.
