Beaumont, TX - Today, Senator Robert Nichols (R-Jacksonville) toured the Beaumont Steel Mill, a local Gerdau Ameristeel plant, in Orange County.

"Plants such as the Beaumont Mill not only supply needed products for our state and our country, but they also provide jobs for local communities," said Senator Nichols. "I am grateful we have such a plant in Southeast Texas."

The Beaumont Mill has a melt shop capacity of 700,000 tons per year and employs approximately 350 individuals. Products, including rebar, wire rod and fabricated materials, made at the Beaumont Mill are used to build roads, bridges and buildings across the country.

"I want to thank Senator Nichols for visiting our facilities this morning," said Gerdau VP/GM Dean Peery. "Senator Nichols understands steel is vital to building a sustainable future in Texas.
