## **Sen. Kelly Hancock Announces District 9 Mobile Office Hours - July 2017**

*Senate staff available to assist area residents with state agency issues in Richland Hills, Watauga*

**NORTH RICHLAND HILLS** - Today, Texas State Senator Kelly Hancock released information regarding this month's Mobile Office Hours for Senate District 9. The program is an effort to assist local residents who could use help resolving an issue with a state agency.

"Cutting through the red tape of government agencies can be a daunting task," said Sen. Hancock. "We want the 800,000-plus constituents of Senate District 9 to know our staff is here to help with that."

Examples of state agency casework include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Child support collection (Office of the Texas Attorney General)
- Handgun licensing (Texas Department of Public Safety)
- Insurance or utility complaints (Texas Department of Insurance / Public Utility Commission)
- State employee retirement benefits (Employee / Teacher Retirement Systems)
