## BIRDWELL ANNOUNCES DEPARTURE OF DISTRICT MANAGER

GRANBURY—Today, State Senator Brian Birdwell (R-Granbury) announced the departure of his Granbury-based District Manager, Suzy DeArmond, effective Jan. 14th. DeArmond has served in this role since the Summer of 2017.

"Since she first joined our team, Suzy has diligently and faithfully served the people of Senate District 22. Birdwell continued, "Countless residents of the District have relied on Suzy to connect them with vital state services and offer assistance in navigating state-level government. As Suzy departs for her next opportunity, we wish her well and express our gratitude for her years of service on behalf of the citizens of Senate District 22."

For the last four and a half years, DeArmond has staffed Senator Birdwell's Granbury District Office and functioned as a liaison and case manager for the various government-related needs of Senate District 22's citizenry.

"While I am excited for a new phase in my career, my departure from Team Birdwell is bittersweet," DeArmond said. "Over these recent years, I have developed a unique admiration for the many different people and places that make up Senate District 22. It was my honor to serve them, and I'll always be grateful to Senator Birdwell for trusting me with that opportunity."

Senator Birdwell concluded by saying, "Finding Suzy's replacement will be no small task, and we are currently in the process of conducting the search to find the next person to fill this role. In the meantime, there will not be any lapse in assistance for my constituents. All constituent services will be temporarily consolidated under operations at my Waco District Office by my Senior District Manager and Special Projects Coordinator Shelly Verlander."

In the next several months leading into the 88th Legislative Session, Birdwell will issue a press release sharing with constituents a complete staff list for his Capitol, district and committee offices.
