SUSPECT NEW WORLD SCREWWORM?

1. LIMIT MOVEMENT

Move the animal to the nearest trailer, concrete pad, tarp or other hard surface to prevent larvae from falling into dirt or pasture. Avoid transporting the animal.

2. REPORT IMMEDIATELY

Contact the Texas Animal Health Commission for livestock related suspicions. Wildlife suspicions can be reported to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. Cases in pets can be reported to your veterinarian.

3. CONTACT YOUR VETERINARIAN

Your veterinarian and TAHC can help determine next steps, including sample collection and submission.
