Governor Abbot Signs 32 Bills by Senator César J. Blanco into Law

Austin, Texas – Sunday, June 19, 2023, was Governor Abbott's deadline to veto or sign into law legislation passed in the 88th Texas Legislative Session. In the veto period following session, Governor Abbott signed 32 bills by Senator César J. Blanco.

Senator Blanco issued the following statement:
